

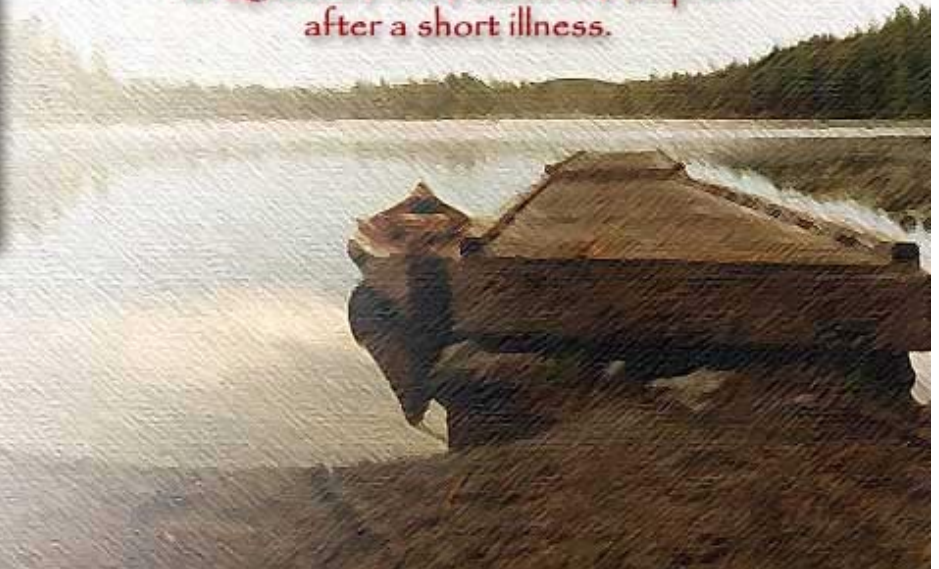
Obituary
